

Gospel F.A.C.T.S. Discussion Guide

Faith

Do you think science and faith are in conflict? Why do you think God looks for faith in his people?

Adam (or Abraham)

Jesus proclaimed the good news of the Kingdom of God/heaven/light and contrasted it with the Kingdom of Satan/darkness (called Dummy World in the video). See Matthew 4:17, 23; 5:3-12; 6:10, 33. Matthew starts his gospel with the genealogy of Jesus going back to Abraham, not Adam as Luke did in his gospel. What do you think Matthew was emphasizing? Jesus said this good news is to be proclaimed throughout the world (Matthew 24:14). What are some ways you can do this?

Christ

The Apostle Paul calls Jesus the second Adam (Romans 5:14; 1 Corinthians 15: 44-49). What do you think this means?

Jesus is God in human form (see Philippians 2:7, John 20:28, 2 Peter 1:1, 1 John 5:20). Why do you think the Son of God became a human?

Transformed

Christians have been transformed from the kingdom of darkness into the kingdom of light ruled by Jesus Christ (Colossians 1:13-20). The world thinks of the church as buildings and wealthy self-serving institutions. How can Christians show the world a different reality.

Spirit

Have you received the Spirit? What do you think it means to "Walk by the Spirit" (Galatians 5:25)?

F.A.C.T.S.

The Apostle Peter said (1 Peter 3:15) said we should always be prepared to explain our faith. How might the Gospel F.A.C.T.S. acronym be used to help you do this?
